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STATEMENT FOR OPEN PUBLIC HEARING,
ART WORKERS COALITION.

FOR ME THERE CAN BE NO ART REVOLUTION
THAT IS SEPARATE FROM A SCIENCE
REVOLUTION, A POLITICAL REVOLUTION,
AN EDUCATION REVOLUTION, A DRUG
REVOLUTION, A SEX REVOLUTION OR A
PERSONAL REVOLUTION. I CANNOT CONSIDER
A PROGRAM OF MUSEUM REFORMS WITHOUT
EQUAL ATTENTION TO GALLERY REFORMS
AND ART MAGAZINE REFORMS WHICH WOULD
AIM TO ELIMINATE STABLES OF ARTISTS
AND WRITERS. I WILL NOT CALL MYSELF
AN ART WORKER BUT RATHER AN ART
DREAMER AND I WILL PARTICIPATE ONLY
IN A TOTAL REVOLUTION SIMULTANEOUSLY
PERSONAL AND PUBLIC.

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
